Friday, October 26, 2012

#### 10a.m: Arrive in Barcelona

Arrive in Barcelona, Spain's second-largest city. As the capital of fiercely nationalistic Cataluña, Barcelona was the hotbed of resistance under the rule of General Franco and celebrates its unique identity through its language, its increasingly influential government, and most recently on the global stage as host to the unforgettable 1992 Olympic Games.

### 12p.m: Arrive at hotel in Barcelona

#### 1pm: Supervised lunch in assigned groups in Barcelona

#### 2p.m: Tour Director-led walking tour of Barcelona

Absorb the colorful and dynamic atmosphere of Barcelona during your walking tour down Las Ramblas; a mile-long treelined pedestrian boulevard which runs from the pulsating Plaza de Catalunya down to the towering monument of Christopher Columbus pointing out to sea. Flower stalls, mime artists, puppeteers, diners and waiters all vie for your attention. You will also see the thrice-burned-down Gran Teatro de Liceu, the nostalgic Café de l'Opera, and still have chance to savor the splendid La Boqueria food market.

### 5:30p.m: Return to the hotel and freshen up for dinner

7:00p.m: Enjoy Dinner in a typical Spanish restaurant in Downtown Barcelona

8:30p.m: Time permitting, enjoy an evening stroll through the streets of Barcelona before heading back to the hotel. Make sure to stop and try Spanish churros with melted chocolate!

#### 8:30a.m: Board the bus for guided sightseeing of Barcelona

#### 9:00a.m: Guided sightseeing of Barcelona

Your guided tour takes you past the controversial and still unfinished La Sagrada Familia (the Church of the Holy Family). This masterpiece of twisting spires and colorful mosaics was designed by Gaudí, who estimated it would take 200 years to complete. You'll also stroll the narrow lanes of the 14th-century Barrio Gótico, the oldest surviving part of the city. Continue on to Gaudí's masterpiece, the fantasyland of Parque Guell, complete with a bright mosaic lizard fountain and the longest bench in the world. Then enjoy a marvelous harbor view from atop Montjuïc Hill, where much of the 1992 Olympics took place.

#### 12:00p.m: Supervised lunch in assigned groups near Parque Guell

#### 1:00p.m: Visit Parque Guell

You'll also visit the Parque Guell, a World Heritage Site designed by Antoni Gaudí. The beautifully landscaped park is decorated with playful Modernist mosaics. Visit the Room of a Hundred Columns, a covered market with 84 pillars, and see the Casa-Museu, where Gaudí lived from 1906 to 1926.

#### 3:00p.m: Visit to La Sagrada Familia

Enter into this amazing skeleton of a cathedral-Gaudi began this church in 1882 and it remains unfinished. Construction still continues and completion is slated for the mid-21st century, yet no one knows if the finished product will be what Gaudi intended. Take your time to explore this bizarre masterpiece by wandering around the base marveling at the enormous statues of saints, or climb one of the many towers for a spectacular view of the city.

#### 7:00p.m: Tapas Dinner in Downtown Barcelona

Tonight you can enjoy the culinary delights of Spain's famous tapas. Coming from the verb tapar (to cover) you will sample local finger foods that range from the tame (breads and cheeses) to the adventurous (exotic meats and seafood). Feasting on tapas is the quintessential Spanish experience!

The Grimaldi family has ruled Monaco since 1297, making them the longest-reigning family dynasty in Europe. See the palace and pass by the Cathédrale de Monaco, site of Prince Rainier's wedding to Grace Kelly in 1956. The cathedral is also the final resting place of both Prince Rainier and Princess Grace, who was killed in a car accident in the hills of Monaco in 1982. Catch a glimpse of the stately casino as you stroll the streets with your tour director. The aura of mystique that surrounds the Monte-Carlo casino stems in part from Mata Hari, the professional dancer-turned-Dutch-spy who once shot a Russian spy inside the ornate landmark.

Indulge in one of life's great pleasures as you visit a local confiserie and sample some of the tasty treats.

Acquaint yourself with the palm trees and promenades of this exclusive seaside resort. Walk in the footsteps of the rich and famous as you stroll through the Vieille Ville, past white-washed villas and down the Promenade des Anglais. Nice's spectacular scenery has inspired such artists as Renoir, Matisse and Toulouse-Lautrec.

Originally created as offices (uffizi) for Cosimo de Medici, the building became a gallery in the 17th century. Today it houses one of the finest collections of Renaissance work anywhere in the world. The three-sided gallery is a treasure-chest of pieces in a perfectly-lit opulent setting, truly a gallery of special taste.

8:00p.m: Enjoy an evening walk in Florence. Work together to find the Vivoli Gelateria, considered by locals and tourists alike as the pinnacle of the gelato art form.

The world's largest dome is located in the world's smallest country. See both as you tour St. Peter's Basilica, erected in Vatican City on the site where the saint was martyred. Enter the basilica under the watchful eyes of the brightly dressed Swiss Guard. Inside, admire Michelangelo's Pietà and try to find the artist's signature (it is the only sculpture he ever signed). Then continue on to the Vatican Museum, where elaborate galleries packed with one artistic masterpiece after another lead you directly to the Sistine Chapel. Between 1508 and 1512, Michelangelo painted some of the world's finest pictorial images on the Chapel's ceiling. This was his first attempt at working in fresco, which he did by standing up and craning backwards from a scaffold.

#### 12:30p.m: Supervised lunch in assigned groups near St. Peter's Square

#### 2:00p.m Guided sightseeing of Rome

Your guided sightseeing of ancient Rome takes you past the ancient Forum Romanum, once the heart of the Roman Empire. You will also visit the Colosseum, where gladiators once battled for their lives in front of 50,000 spectators. During a guided walk, stroll through the Piazza Venezia and view the Pantheon, the temple to "all the gods." End at the Trevi Fountain, a favorite meeting spot for tourists and locals alike.

# 5:00p.m Enjoy supervised time around the Spanish Steps. See the famous designer boutiques of Versace, Prada, Gucci, and many others while grabbing a slice of traditional Italian pizza.

7:30p.m: Enjoy an Italian dinner in Rome surrounded by the beautiful sites of central Rome

10:30p.m: Return to the hotel

11:00p.m: Supervision, room checks by chaperones and lights out
