WALKING OR CYCLING TO SCHOOL

As we start the 2018-2019 school year, we would like our families to remind and encourage students to consider walking or cycling to and from school. There are many benefits to walking and cycling to school. It:

- Improves student academic performance by making students more alert and better prepared to learn.
- Contributes to the daily goal of 60 minutes of moderate or vigorous activity for students, improving their health and overall fitness.
- Reduces traffic congestion and improves safety for everyone in school zones.
- Promotes life-long habits that foster independence and active lifestyles, preparing students for their future.

For those who can't walk or cycle to school every day, choosing active travel once, twice, or a few days a week can still provide benefits. You can also consider parking a block away from the school and letting students walk the rest of the way. Include active travel as part of your family's daily routine!

Please also be aware of some unique parking lot issues at Markville. We have a gaggle of geese who have been visiting throughout the day and can sometimes block certain areas of the parking lot. Please have patience and respect the local wildlife. Parents and Guardians are reminded that the 4 accessible parking spaces are only to be used with a valid accessible parking permit. These spaces are not to be used as regular parking spots when picking students up at the end of the day. We have both students and parents who are in genuine need of these reserved spots and ask that they remain clear for those that do require them. Please do not block these spots so drivers are able to access them.
