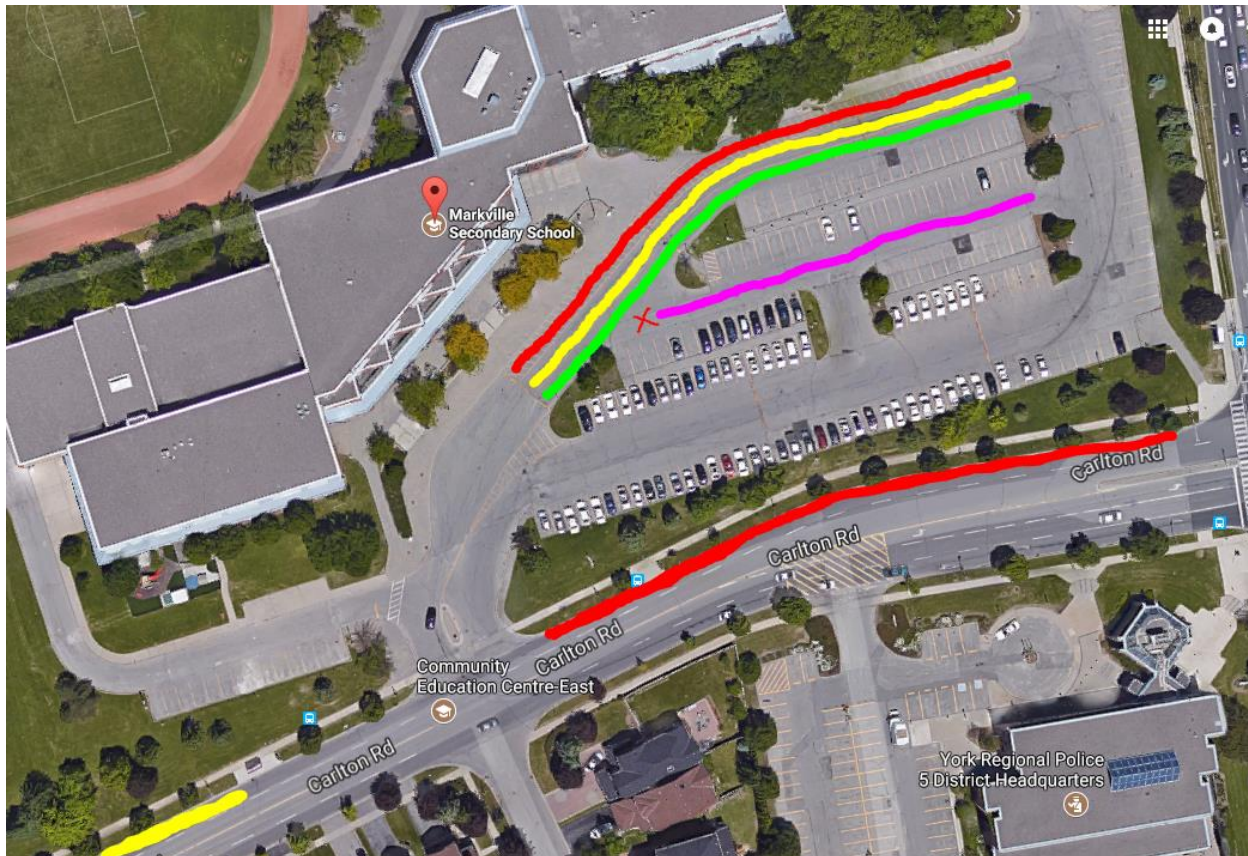

As we heard at the meeting, parking lot safety continues to be a concern. We would like to remind parents that the areas marked in red on the map below are NOT acceptable drop off points. There should be no stopping on Carlton Road in front of the parking lot; it is just too dangerous for the students to then cross in front of traffic going in different directions to get through the parking lot. For the safety of our students, staff, and visitors, please only stop to drop off students in the areas marked in **YELLOW**. Please also note the area marked in purple is for staff parking only, it is not meant to be used as a drive through option. With your co-operation we can continue to keep our students safe!

Senior phys. ed. classes have been taking advantage of community recreational facilities. So far they have been introduced to tennis at the Unionville Tennis Club and golf at the Fairtree Golf Centre.

Future field trips include a day at Skyzone Trampoline Park and Ski and Snowboarding at Mount St. Louis Moonstone.
