## **IMPORTANT ANNOUNCEMENT(S)**

On March 30<sup>th</sup>, 2017, Grade 10 students at Markville S.S. and across the province will write the Ontario Secondary School Literacy Test (OSSLT). It will also be written by students who were previously eligible but have not yet written the test or who were unsuccessful on their first attempt. The OSSLT is administered by the Education Quality and Accountability Office (EQAO), an independent agency of the Government of Ontario, in order to determine whether students have acquired the minimum literacy skills expected by *The Ontario Curriculum* across all subject areas up to the end of Grade 9.

Please note that this date is the only opportunity for students to write the OSSLT. Students who are absent will have to wait until the next school year to write.

Students who are expected to write the OSSLT received information letters prior to the March Break. These letters indicated the room in which they will be writing the OSSLT. In addition, an information assembly will be held Tuesday, March 28<sup>th</sup> for all students writing. The assembly will provide an overview of the day, key reminders for the OSSLT, and an opportunity for students to ask questions.

For the benefit of students writing the test, we wish to provide a quiet and focused environment for completing the OSSLT; therefore, students who are not writing the OSSLT will come to school approximately three and a half hours later than usual. After completion of the OSSLT, all students will follow a modified schedule with shortened class periods (as outlined below).

#### STUDENT NUTRITION PROGRAM

Markville's Breakfast Club is running the school nutrition program in which students continue to actively promote healthy snack options.
