- Creates safer neighbourhoods


Join the movement! We encourage all our staff and students to Walk or Wheel for the month of October.

LIBRARY LEARNING COMMONS

All Grade 9 classes were invited to participate in an interactive orientation to the Library Learning Commons over the past two weeks. This is part of the transition activities for students as they adjust to high school life. We used the <u>HP Reveal</u> app to explore the Library, which allowed students to learn about the spaces, resources, guidelines, helpful information, and all the cool stuff the Library has available. Students were then invited to fill out a Google Quiz to test their new knowledge. If you would like to see an example of how the <u>HP Reveal</u> app works, follow these simple instructions – or ask a Grade 9 student to show you if they haven't done so already!

- 1. Download the HP Reveal app (it's free)
- 2. Sign up for a free account if you would prefer not to have your own account, you can sign into our general library one:
 - Username: GenLib
 - Password: 407lib
- 3. Follow us by searching for: msslibrary (the one with the most likes)
- 4. Click on the blue view button at the bottom of the page.
- 5. Point your phone or device at any Markville Student Card and you should see a video start.

The HP Reveal app is also used in Markville SS yearbooks. This is a great introduction to augmented reality and its uses.
