They learned how and where to find resources both here in the collection as well as online from home.

Students were able to discover on their own the learning zones and resources available to them. We encourage all students to explore what we have to offer, from the green screen studio, podcast kit, online databases, DVDs, printing, puzzles, silent study space, collaboration space, books, and much, much more!
