

From November 17th through November 23rd, all Grade 9 Period 4 classes were visited by Student Success and TAC Mentors to discuss *Study Skills Strategies for Success*.

These presentations are designed to emphasize the importance of developing effective study habits in Grade 9. Students learned about the value of having study schedules, eliminating distractions during study, and strategies to cope with stress and anxiety.
