

LUNAR NEW YEAR CELEBRATIONS AT MARKVILLE SS

On Thursday, February 7th, students participated in Markville's first ever Lunar New Year Celebrations. A committee of ELL students planned and ran the event under the supervision of Ms. Mathura-Matos and Ms. Sheriff.

During third and fourth periods the traditional red envelopes, "laisee", were distributed to approximately 900 students in the cafeteria and atrium. Inside the envelopes were a chocolate coin, symbolic of the money that is typically given, as well as a hopeful New Year's message. The committee wanted to share some of their cultural traditions with the Markville community.

In addition to this, a variety show which took place after school was the main attraction of the day. In many Asian countries, it is typical to celebrate the New Year with a variety show, showcasing songs, dance, and comedy; and Markville's variety show was not short of either! Performances included solos, duets, and groups singing Chinese pop songs and ballads; instrumental performances on the piano, flute, and violin; a dance routine while simultaneously playing the violin; and an entertaining routine of burping and impressions.

A student and one of the organizers, Jerry Lu, commented that, "it was a lot of fun". He hopes the variety show becomes an annual celebration of Lunar New Year at Markville Secondary School.
