




TECHNOLOGY DEPARTMENT

The **Computer Engineering** classes have been introduced to Micro-controllers such as Arduino, Computer Architecture and Electronic components. By acquiring these essential skills, students are able to build a PCB (Printed Circuit Board) of their choice. Through our labs, experiments, and individual projects, students are applying their mathematics, scientific knowledge and problem solving in the electronic designing process.






The **Architectural Design** classes have been busy working with the new 3D printers. The students have wrapped up their designs and prints for a child's toy. They are now beginning their 3D playground assignments. Starting with the concept of "Discovery and Safety," the students have conceptualized, drawn, and modelled playground designs for children 6-11yrs of age. These playgrounds have been a huge success – look for these future designs to be popping up in a park near you!








The **Communication Technology** classes have been working on many real world projects this year. The Graphic Design courses have been working on the school yearbook, social awareness graphic T-shirts, word art, and climate change animations.







The Grade 9 **Exploring Technologies** course has the students designing and creating Cybermasks, Photoshop illustrations, and building small cars that are powered by mouse traps! Boy did they fly! The students are rotating through each area of technology with specialized teachers, sampling a variety of technological experiences.



The **Woodworking** classes have been studying a broad range of career opportunities available in the manufacturing sector. They have also been planning and fabricating various projects centered on furniture and household design.







The Technological Studies Department at Markville Secondary School also offers a Certificate of Endorsement in Technological Education for the Ontario Graduation Diploma. This Certificate of Endorsement is a **ministry document** that is recognized by College and University entrance programs.
