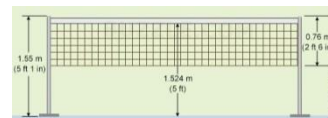
Tier 1 Mens' Doubles - Jeffrey Chen/ Jason Zhang - 4th place

The athletes showed dedication and commitment throughout the season. The coaches would like to thank the team for their hard work all season long.



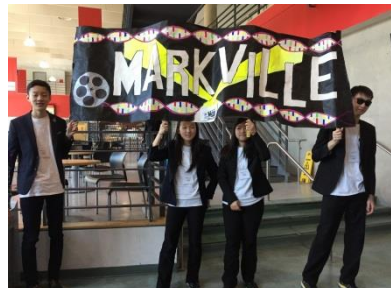
SCIENCE OLYMPICS
