MATH DEPARTMENT

Over the course of the year, the Math department hosted several Math contests for students in Grades 9-12. Math contests are an excellent extra-curricular opportunity for students to have fun and develop their mathematical problem solving abilities.

In February, 113 students in grades 9-11 wrote the University of Waterloo Pascal, Caley, and Fermat Math contests.

April was a busy month for Math contests once again at Markville - a total of 98 students wrote the Euclid Math contest and 114 students in Grades 9-11 wrote the Fryer, Galois, and Hypatia contests.

The following students will receive a medal for achieving the **top score** amongst Markville students:

Markville's team scores and rankings were very impressive this year.

The Pascal team score ranked 3rd in the zone and in the top 2% of all schools in Ontario and in Canada; the Caley team score ranked 7th in the zone and in the top 4% of all schools in Ontario and in Canada; the Fermat team score ranked 4th in the zone and in the top 2% of all schools in Ontario and in Canada.

The Fryer team score ranked 3rd in the zone and in the top 4% of all schools in Ontario and in Canada; the Galois team score ranked 4th in the zone and in the top 3% of all schools in Ontario and in Canada; Hypatia team score ranked 6th in the zone and in the top 4% of schools in Ontario and in Canada.

The Euclid team score ranked 9th in the zone and in the top 3% of all schools in Ontario and in Canada.
