Message from Guidance

SUMMER SCHOOL IS OPEN

Hello Markville Families;

Just a quick note to let you know that Summer School is now open for students to register. Students will use their **MyPathway Planner accounts in order to sign up**. They also must fill out a **Google Form available on the Guidance Google classroom**. The Google Form will act as confirmation of Guardian approval. Students **do not** have to hand in a printed copy of the registration. The student's registration will not be approved until the Google Form is completed and the Summer School Course is selected in myBlueprint.

There are two choices for summer school. Acceleration courses allow a student to complete an entire course in a **4 week** period. Reinforcement courses are **2 week** courses that allow a student who has been <u>unsuccessful at receiving a credit</u> to recover that credit. However, they <u>must have been granted permission</u> by the Principal to take this 2 week selection.

Registration is now open for ACCELERATION COURSES ONLY.

If you want to sign up for a **REINFORCEMENT COURSE**, you must wait until registration for these courses opens, which should occur soon.

Acceleration courses (4 weeks) are run In-Person at area schools, as well as Online (Asynchronous).

Reinforcement courses will run Remotely (Synchronously).

All Summer School In-Person and Remote courses run from **8:45-3:33pm, with two 15 min breaks and a 40 min lunch. Full attendance is required** to attain the credit.

Summer School In-Person Acceleration Courses run from JULY 5 to JULY 28. Online Learning Acceleration courses run from JULY 4 to JULY 27.

Students taking **Reinforcement Courses have a choice of two 2 week sessions**. Session 1 will begin July 6 to July 17 Session 2 will begin July 18 to July 28 Summer School in-person **course choices and locations** can be viewed on the YRDSB website, as well as on <u>MyBlueprint by clicking Continuing Education in the left Tab and</u> <u>'Explore Courses.</u>' Students will choose the school location that is convenient to them. Example: **Sec – Summer School In-Person Milliken Mills HS**

The closest schools to Markville are Milliken Mills, Markham District and Pierre Elliott Trudeau.

Online courses, can be viewed in myBlueprint by selecting **Sec – Summer Online Learning** (Asynchronous)

International Languages courses are viewed under Sec – Summer Remote Learning (Synchronous)
