Dear Families and Community Members,

It seems like it was just yesterday when we were beginning the October Break, yet after a very busy and productive eight weeks, the Winter Break has finally arrived.

As is the tradition at our school, on October 31 SAC planned a variety of fun activities for students and staff. To celebrate Halloween while providing students with an opportunity to meet staff, we were excited to have our 2nd annual Staff Halloween Costume BINGO. Students had the opportunity to pick up a BINGO card in the atrium of the school which included a list of staff who were wearing costumes. Students that participated went around the school on a search to have their bingo card stamped by those staff members. Successful students were rewarded with a bag filled with a variety of yummy treats!

November 1 was Take Our Kids to Work Day. As students in grade 9 visited the workplace of a family member, our school welcomed grade 8 students and their teachers from our elementary partner schools. 
