Letter to Families



THE EDUCATION CENTRE - AURORA

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Dear Families,

Each year the York Region District School Board staff work collaboratively to balance student enrolment and accommodation needs in an effort to ensure that students living in a school attendance area can attend their local secondary school. Further, those accepted on transfer into courses and/or programs outside their home school attendance area need to be accommodated without displacing or limiting opportunity for students who live locally. This letter is to inform you of secondary schools open and closed to student transfer requests for the 2023-24 school year in order to assist students in the transfer process and their course selection and pathway choices.

A. The following schools will <u>not</u> be accepting new student transfer requests for the 2023-2024 school year:

CEC Central: Aurora High School (for French Immersion), Bayview Secondary School, Richmond Hill High School

CEC East: Markville Secondary School, Pierre Elliott Trudeau High School, Unionville High School

CEC North: Newmarket High School

CEC West: Hodan Nalayeh Secondary School (for French Immersion), Stephen Lewis

Secondary School

B. The following schools will be open to new student transfer requests for the 2023-2024 school year:

CEC Central: Alexander Mackenzie High School, Aurora High School (only

for Regular Track), Dr. G. W. Williams Secondary School, King City Secondary School, Langstaff Secondary School,

Richmond Green Secondary School

CEC East: Bill Hogarth Secondary School, Bur Oak Secondary School,

Markham District High School, Middlefield Collegiate

Institute, Milliken Mills High School

CEC North: Dr. John M. Denison Secondary School, Huron Heights

Secondary School, Keswick High School, Sir William Mulock Secondary School, Stouffville District Secondary School,

Sutton District High School

CEC West: Emily Carr Secondary School, Hodan Nalayeh Secondary

School (only for Regular Track), Maple High School,

Thornhill Secondary School, Thornlea Secondary School, Tommy Douglas Secondary School, Westmount Collegiate

Transfer Process:

Note:

- "Home school" refers to the YRDSB school you are designated to attend based on your home address.
- Where your signature is required, either an electronic signature or full name entered in the signature field will be accepted as a signature.

By February 3, 2023, Families interested in a student transfer must request an electronic Transfer Request form and submit it as indicated below:

- YRDSB Grade 8 students request the <u>Transfer Request form</u> from their current elementary school. Complete the form and email to your current elementary school. If "other" is selected as the reason for request, your Principal will contact you to discuss the request.
- YRDSB Secondary school students request and email the completed form to their current secondary school. If "other" is selected as the reason for request, your Principal will contact you to discuss the request.
- Students new to YRDSB for Secondary School request and email the completed form to their YRDSB designated secondary home school (as indicated in school locator) along with a registration form. If "other" is selected as the reason for request, the Principal of your YRDSB designated secondary home school will contact you to discuss the request.

By February 13, 2023, students will be notified of the decision of their transfer request.

On February 16, 2023, YRDSB Grade 8 students will be mapped to their transfer school (if approved) and can begin submitting their courses in *My Pathway Planner*.

By February 24, 2023 by 4 pm course selections are due as indicated below:

- YRDSB Grade 8 students will complete course selection in My Pathway Planner.
- YRDSB secondary school students and secondary school students new to YRDSB will complete course selection as indicated by the secondary school.

For more information on attendance areas and student transfers, families are encouraged to review the process outlined in <u>Board Policy #108 Student Accommodation – Attendance Areas and Student Transfers</u>. If you have questions about the Transfer process please contact your home school.


Message from Peer Tutoring and Student Success

Message From Guidance

POST-SECONDARY INFORMATION

Reminder that **Applications to OUAC are due January 12th** for equal consideration, and **Applications to OCAS are due February 1st**.

GRADE 12 students are encouraged to apply prior to Break, or over the Break, to avoid any issues as January 12th/February 1st approach. OUAC and OCAS will be on Holidays in December/January - please factor that into your timing, again, in case you run into issues.

Guidance presented to **Gr 12 students on December 13th** @ about **Supplementary** support, and can be accessed on the <u>Guidance Website</u>.

COURSE SELECTION

Course Selection will be open for submission on **February 16**, **closing on February 24**, **2023**. Students can enter courses at any point now, but MUST be locked in by February 24th. There is <u>no advantage</u> to submitting early, so please make your selection carefully, as elective changes (unless pathway changes) can be incredibly challenging.

IMPORTANT: Students in **Grade 10 and 11** should be exploring Post-Secondary interests to review program requirements, so as to be able to choose potentially required Grade 11&12 prerequisite courses for next year's **Course Selection** in February. It is recommended to take time, where possible, to do this over the Break, if students have not done so already. Course selection options/information can be found here on the Guidance website, as well as reviewing post-secondary information and links <a href=here. Families are reminded of the opportunity to review the College/University/Apprenticeships pathways information on the Family Night page, where you will also find the Agenda with the Meeting links to our upcoming January and February Family Night Presentations on **Specialty Programs** and **Course Selection**, to aid you in supporting your child with decision-making as they select their courses for next year.
