Packs", we were given the opportunity to receive a class set of snowshoes.

This year, mother nature provided us with a large amount of snow, which enabled some of the grade 9 classes to head outdoors and enjoy the sport of snowshoeing. Prior to taking students outdoors, they were shown a powerpoint highlighting the history of snowshoes. This presentation provided students the opportunity to gain a deeper knowledge of the land and an appreciation of contemporary and traditional First Nation, Metis and Inuit traditions, cultures and perspectives.

The benefits of snowshoeing are incredible, even at an easy walking pace they burn up to 1000 calories an hour!!


# **Peer Tutoring**


