This presentation is for Gr 11 and 12 families, and will cover OSAP, Scholarships, and general information that can aid in saving families money for post-secondary.

#### SUMMER CO-OP INFORMATION:

Summer Co-op Programs are offered through Continuing Education and supported by Curriculum & Instructional Services. Summer Co-op is available for students entering Grade 11 or 12 in the fall. However, Grade 12 students who could not fit co-op into their regular timetables and require it for graduation will be given priority. Students must be available for all scheduled dates.

There will be a summer co-op information session for students held virtually on February 12, 2025 from 4pm - 5pm. All students interested in applying are encouraged to attend. Students can register for the information session through <u>yrdsb.cc/summercoopinfo</u>.

SHSM 2-Credit Co-op: Mackenzie Health & Scarborough Health Network	This program has an early registration deadline. The SHSM Summer Co-op Program is for SHSM students in the Health & Wellness or Business sectors (for non-clinical positions), interested in working at Mackenzie Health/Cortellucci Hospital <u>or</u> Scarborough Health Network. Students may only apply to one hospital of their choice. Application is limited to SHSM students entering Grade 12 who could not schedule Co-op into their regular timetables. This program is being offered in collaboration with YRDSB and YCDSB. The SHSM 2-credit summer co-op program is a blended learning model running from May 6, 2025 to August 1, 2025. Pre-placement classes will take place in-person and virtually from 5:00-9:00 pm. In-person classes will take place at Richmond Green Secondary School at 1 William F. Bell Pkwy, Richmond Hill, ON L4S 2T9.	Registration Link Opens: Friday, February 14, 2025 at 9:00 a.m. Closes: Monday, February 24, 2025 by 4:00 p.m.

1-Credit ALEP	One Credit ALEP is available to students in grades 10–12 interested in earning a credit in July through a paid placement. Students will participate in remote/in-person learning and will be required to have a full-time job from July 2, 2025 to July 25, 2025. Employers must meet with the summer ALEP teacher for a placement assessment before students are accepted into the program. Program Dates • July 2 - July 25 (approximately 40 hours/week) • Pre-placement and integration classes will be determined with the summer ALEP teacher.	Registration will open with regular summer school through My Pathways Planner in April.

All programs are pending enrollment and availability. Students will be contacted by the Pathways team in Curriculum and Instructional Services when their enrolment is confirmed. #### **COURSE SELECTION - FOR NEXT YEAR:**

**Course Selection** will be open in <u>myBluePrint/myPathwayPlanner</u> for submission on **February 13, closing on February 21, 2025**. Students can enter courses at any point now, but MUST be locked in by February 21st. There is <u>no advantage</u> to submitting early, so please make your selection carefully, as elective changes (unless pathway changes) can be incredibly challenging.

**IMPORTANT:** Students in **Grade 10 and 11** should be exploring Post-Secondary interests to review program requirements, so as to be able to choose potentially required Grade 11&12 pre-requisite courses in February for next year's **Course Selection**. Course selection options/information can be found here on the Guidance website, as well as reviewing post-secondary information and links here. Gr 11 research information can be examined here, as well as a presentation that was delivered to Grade 10s here (scroll down in the link). Courses must be locked in by February 21<sup>st</sup>. FOR MATH-BASED decisions, please use this <u>RESOURCE</u> to help you understand the options.

#### POST-SECONDARY INFORMATION

VERY IMPORTANT: Gr 12 Students will want to confirm that their courses are in and accurate in OUAC and OCAS.

Please ensure that any Private School or alternative Board report cards are submitted to Markville Guidance. Private schools must upload to OUAC/OCAS, but the <u>course does not count towards a student Transcript</u>, <u>unless MSS uploads the</u> <u>report card</u>. **Private schools can email counsellors directly**; TDSB, etc would need to be provided via the student asap.

Students in external Public Board Night School IN SEMESTER 2 need to walk into Guidance to ensure their courses are visible in the system. Sem 2 Private courses must be made visible by the Private schools.
