**Details:** Staff will be engaged in learning related to:

- · developing relationships and identity-affirming working and learning environments;
- · identifying warning signs that a person's behaviour may be escalating;
- · responding to escalations using specific strategies;
- exploring case studies;
- · following reporting procedures; and
- accessing support and resources.

- preparation for Semester 2
- · high yield instructional strategies in the de-streamed Math, Science, or English classroom
- · data analysis for school improvement

**Details:** School teams will engage in School Improvement Planning facilitated by school leaders. Topics will vary by subject and may include:

- · embedding strategies to support teaching multilingual language learners into the curriculum;
- · embedding subject specific high yield strategies into instruction and assessment; and
- · data analysis for school improvement.

School Teams will continue to engage in School Improvement Planning that supports the implementation of equitable assessment practices, curriculum changes and instructional strategies to support students in the de-streamed classroom.

### Message from Guidance

#### **COURSE SELECTION**

**Course Selection** will be open for submission on **February 15**, **closing on February 24**, **2024**. Students can enter courses at any point now, but MUST be locked in by February 24th. There is <u>no advantage</u> to submitting early, so please make your selection carefully, as elective changes (unless pathway changes) can be incredibly challenging. Assemblies for students

will take place on February 7th. Details for family information regarding course selection are below (Family Night Webinar).

**IMPORTANT:** Students currently in **Grade 10 and 11** should be exploring Post-Secondary interests to review program requirements, so as to be able to choose potentially required Grade 11&12 pre-requisite courses in February for next year's **Course Selection**. It is recommended for Gr 10s to also put in courses for Gr 12, so that they can ensure the correct pre-requisites in Gr 11 (only Gr 11 courses will be locked in the system). Course selection options/information can be found here, as well as Department pathways on the Guidance website. Post-secondary information and links can be reviewed here.

#### **FAMILY NIGHT WEBINAR SERIES**
