BFCN will once again be awarding six \$1000 scholarships and awards to Black students pursuing post-secondary education in accredited Canadian institutions. All online applications and supporting documents must be submitted by July 31, 2024.

BFCN Scholarship

This year, BFCN will be awarding four \$1000 scholarships to qualifying students pursuing education at an accredited Canadian University or College in September 2024. Two scholarships will be awarded to undergraduate students and two scholarships will be awarded to graduate students.

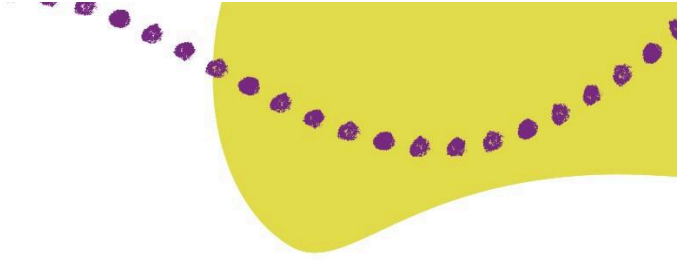

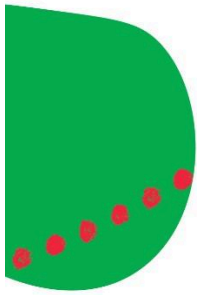
