Parent-Teacher Interviews

Parent-Teacher Interview Night will be held on **Wednesday, March 29, 2023**. You will have an opportunity to meet with your child(ren)'s teacher(s) in person, and learn more about the classroom. To maintain maximum flexibility for families, in situations where a parent is requesting a virtual interview, and little availability remains in the interview schedule, teachers are asked to explore other dates to connect (phone or video) with families.

Families can use Edsby, an online platform, to schedule a meeting time with their child(ren)'s teacher(s) on Parents' Night. You will receive an invitation to sign up for a meeting time once the schedules are available.

<u>Edsby</u> is a cloud-based platform that lets families easily reserve times to meet with your child(ren)'s teachers. YRDSB in partnership with Edsby have created a secure platform that protects the privacy of information for families.

Families that already have an Edsby account may use their previously created account. The username is the full email address that is on file at Markville and the password is the one created at activation. If you have forgotten your password, you can find <u>resources on the Board website</u> to help, including how to reset your password.

Families who **do not have** an Edsby account will need to create one to access the online appointment scheduler for their child's teachers for Parents' Night. **An up-to-date and valid email address must be provided to your child's home school.** For help creating an Edsby account, <u>instructions can be found on the Board website</u>. An email from York Region District School Board with instructions on how to create an Edsby account was sent to your email inbox on March 7, 2023. If you do not receive the email, please check your junk mail folder to ensure you do not miss this opportunity.

If you have any questions about this process, please contact our main office. Families who do not wish to book a time on Edsby or are not available on October 20th can contact the classroom teacher directly.

Attention Markville Families with Students Returning to Markville for the 2023-24 School Year
Thank you to all of our students who submitted courses for next year by the deadline. We have a
record of all choices. We are now allowing students to do a final check that the courses are correct. A
link to a Google Form will be available to all students to request a change if needed. It will be active
from Thursday, March 9th at 3 pm to Tuesday, March 21st at 3 pm. The link will be posted on the
Guidance Google Classroom or you can have your student use the QR Code below to access the link.

Course Check and Change Request

ONLY TO BE COMPLETED BY STUDENTS REQUESTING A CHANGE TO THEIR SELECTED COURSES FOR 2023/24

This is the final opportunity to make a change to your 2023-24 course selection, until the start of the new school year in August (with typically limited options at that point).

1. Students are to review their updated high school plan on MyPathwayPlanner/myBlueprint. Check your course codes carefully to make sure you did not make an error recording the course code.

A CHANGE WAS MADE BY GUIDANCE IF:

- Students have mistakenly chosen 9 courses/credits instead of 8 (Coop sometimes affected this, and only 9 are permitted with music repertoire as the 9th course) Guidance removed an elective in this situation.
- Grade 11 students selecting only 7 courses. Spares are not permitted for grade 11 course selections an alternate was used in the final submission in such cases.
- 2. SUMMER SCHOOL: Sign-up date is early April via myBlueprint (Guidance will announce). Registration information will be provided prior. If you are planning to complete a summer course, you will NOT include that course in your MSS course selection for next year please replace it with an elective.
- 3. Students are to confirm their changes with a Parent/Guardian when completing this form.

You will have between Thursday, March 9th, 3 pm and Tuesday, March 21st at 3 pm to fill out the Google Form to request a change.




