TIMETABLING

IMPORTANT & Time-Sensitive: DaySchool Online Learning Courses 2025-26

Current Gr 10 or 11 students who are interested in DROPPING or ADDING a DaySchool Online (DSOL) course next year, can occur at this time. Courses will fill quickly. Please come to Guidance in the very near future (book or come in) if you are interested in DROPPING a course you selected during course selection, or ADDING one to next year's timetable.

- All requests to reserve a seat are dependent on availability.
- If a course is at capacity the student will be placed on a waitlist.

With the exception of ConEd Dayschool Online learning, MSS has moved onto the next stage of developing the 25-26 Timetable, using student selections from February and recent Course Change opportunities. At this time, there is no

possibility of making any further changes to next year's selection. Students who need a PATHWAY change (require a course that is a pre-req for Gr 12 or post-secondary, or Applied to Academic/Academic to Applied, or College to Uni/Uni to College) should book an appointment with Guidance for planning.

POST-SECONDARY INFORMATION


