

GUIDANCE FYIS:

Gr 10 Post-Secondary RESEARCH presentation will be delivered to Gr 10 students virtually in the Gr 9/10 Google Classroom on **November 25th @ 3:30pm**, to provide an abundance of information regarding post-secondary in advance of the February Course Selection. This will ensure students are informed and can do research prior to choosing Gr 11 courses.

Relevant to Gr 11s and 12s:

- Note: Full Disclosure is November 27th. Courses removed prior to this date do not appear on a Transcript. Reminder that post-secondary institutions do NOT say no to students based on Gr 11 achievement, they will simply wait to see how Gr 12 progresses.
- Grade 12 marks were uploaded to OCAS on November 15th, and OUAC on November 19th.

IMPORTANT:

- Grade 12 students currently taking a course in Private School need to ensure that their Private School uploads their Mid-Term mark to OCAS/OUAC, or have at the very least uploaded that the student is currently in the course (colleges/universities will bypass a student for consideration if they do not see a course projected). It is the responsibility of the Private School to upload their courses and grades to OCAS/OUAC.
- Students should also ensure that Guidance is aware that they are taking a Private course, as they will need to have the Private School directly provide a <u>final</u> mark to Guidance at the end of the semester for Transcript purposes.
- ALL students taking a TDSB or Catholic School eLearning/Night School course, must provide Guidance with their Mid-Term mark for upload to OCAS/OUAC.
