Tuesday October 27th. Please check Teach Assist to find out which cohort your child is in for Period 5 Face to Face. Remember you will need your child's password to access Teach Assist.

Cohort may be different from the last rotation.

A few reminders about safe and best practices for student learning and safety:

- If a student does attend school on the wrong cohort day, they will be sent home. Cohorts are created to keep everyone as safe as possible, so this is necessary.
- Afternoon online classes will consist of 40 minutes of synchronous learning with the remaining 10 minutes for independent work and / or time for students to stretch, get a drink, etc.

Edsby is a cloud-based platform that lets families easily reserve times to meet with their child(ren)'s teachers. YRDSB in partnership with Edsby has created a secure platform that protects the privacy of information for families.

Families that already have an Edsby account may use their previously created account. The username is the full email address that is on file at your child(ren)'s home school and the password is the one created at activation. If you have forgotten your password, you can check <u>resources on the Board website</u> to help, including how to reset your password.

Families who **do not have** an Edsby account will need to create one to access the online appointment scheduler for their child's teachers for Parents' Night. **An up-to-date and valid email address must be provided to your child's home school.** For help creating an Edsby account, please follow: <u>instructions can be found on the Board</u> <u>website</u>. An email from York Region District School Board with instructions on how to create an Edsby account was sent on **October 13**. If you did not receive the email, please check your junk mail folder to ensure you do not miss this opportunity.

Families who do not wish to book a time online can contact the teacher for a telephone interview. Teachers have blocked appointment time slots to accommodate these appointments.

Halloween Reminders for Families



This year Halloween will look different for York Region families. In light of COVID-19 precautions, door-to-door trick-or-treating is <u>not</u> <u>recommended</u> by Ontario's Chief Medical Officer of Health for modified Stage 2 areas, including York Region.

The health and safety of our students remains a top priority. For students who wish to celebrate Halloween at school, please keep these reminders in mind:

· When planning costumes, no replica weapons of any kind are allowed.

• Costumes should be respectful of others. Symbols or objects representative of a person's culture or religious beliefs should not be worn as a costume.

Due to COVID-19 precautions, please be aware that:

Students will not be able to use washrooms to change into costumes.

• No Halloween masks are to be worn and students should only use single use makeup (no sharing of make-up).

• Students who are required to wear PPE face masks (Gr. 4 - 12) must continue to do so, and students in younger grade (FDK - Gr. 3) are encouraged to continue to wear their PPE face masks.

• Costumes should be of simple design (to limit personal items being brought to school), and treats cannot be shared.

CUCIO.C3 > Sharpen Your Mind

Curio videos can now be viewed with a lesson posted in the Google classroom. Students can click the link and the video will launch without any need to enter any passwords or other authentication. If a teacher instructs students to use Curio.ca as a research tool, the teacher must provide the code **P8UA-CGPM**. The student can create an account using their **@gapps.yrdsb.ca** email to authenticate their subscription access.

There is also access to BBC Channel, National Geographic and News in Review (current edition and archives) within Curio which is from CBC.
