All students in our school currently have a TeachAssist account to access information associated with their class assessments. Parents/guardians may access appointment bookings through the TeachAssist Parent Portal available at https://ta.yrdsb.ca/parents. From there, enter in your email address and leave the password blank, to set up a one time access link, or to reset a password that you've created.

- Students in Grade 12 who are interested in applying for one of the Accelerated OYAP Level 1 Training programs (note: students must have 4 credit Co-op/ALEP on their timetable in semester 2 and have completed 26+ credits towards their OSSD)
- Students in Grades 10-12 who are interested in learning more about apprenticeship and OYAP programming and;
- Parents/guardians/educators who want to learn more about OYAP and Accelerated OYAP opportunities.

The application for the semester 2 accelerated OYAP programs is now open. The direct link to it is - https://yrdsb.cc/OYAPapplication. The application deadline is Friday, November 8th. Students applying should be in communication with Co-op.

The following is a brief summary of the **Accelerated OYAP Program Eligibility**:

- Graduating Grade 12 students
- Completed 40 hrs. community service and literacy test (or OLC40)
- Registered in a 4 credit Co-op in Semester 2 of Grade 12
- Must be sponsored by an employer/Co-op placement to be signed as an apprentice by the time the accelerated OYAP program begins.
- Have related technical and/or Co-op experience and/or work experience and a strong interest in Skilled Trades
- Transit to and from the location of the accelerated OYAP level 1 programming is required.
