Daily School Screening for Students

Student Self-Assessment Process:

Students and their families received a communication with the information below, including the necessary links:

- Step 1: Students complete on-line self-assessment:
[COVID-19 School and Child-Care Screening Tool](#)
- Step 2: Upon completion of self-assessment, students respond to the question “Have you completed the self-screening test?” in the confirmation [Form](#)
 - Students receive an email response when they respond “Yes”, which will include a colour for each specific day of the week:
Monday, Tuesday, Wednesday, Thursday, Friday
- Step 3: Period 1 teacher checks with students **prior to students entering the classroom**
 - Students who indicate they did not complete the self-assessment need to be directed to the tool posted in the classroom to review and provide verbal response

Thank you for your support as we all work together to keep everyone safe at school.

Parking Lot

Our parking lot went through a major transformation over the summer of 2019. Consultants listened to the safety concerns of parents / guardians, students, staff, and community members and came up with a redesign to address these issues. The parking section is now self-contained, so anyone coming to park at the school will not have to cross traffic to get safely to the school doors. The new drop off circle is meant for short term pick-ups and drop offs only. To reduce congestion, we always recommend that students walk or bike to school – even when it’s raining! If this is not possible, consider a pick up point away from the school such as the Centennial

Community Centre. We appreciate your patience and cooperation as we all adjust to the traffic flow.

- Watch for your **voter information card** in the mail




- Make a plan to vote**
