1. E-bulletin

- A pilot project is in the works to see what feedback is received, with a plan to roll out in Sept
- Email addresses will need to be kept current, could be a challenge

- 2. Light up your World Anti Bullying Workshop
 - Grade 10 students have the most success with this workshop
 - Due to the cost, instead of offering to all grade 10's, 30 students have been chosen by the school to participate in the one day workshop.
 - The goal is to empower them and give them a better sense of self to help them counteract bullying

3. IPP Update (Individual Pathway Plan)
