Credit Rescue is a student success support program that is offered during the culminating period. This program provides students with the opportunity to complete missing assignments with the support of a teacher to achieve a passing grade in one or more of their at-risk courses. Particular focus is given to supporting Grade 9 and 10 students with the goal of achieving all their credits.

We have had great success with our internal Credit Rescue programs here at Markville. Every semester, we are able to support students in rescuing a number of credits and achieve success!
