## Faith Day: Rosh Hashanah: Begins September 15 at Sundown

Rosh Hashanah is the Jewish New Year and literally translates as "head of the year". It begins a solemn ten-day period of contemplation and self-examination, called the Days of Awe, which end with the Day of Atonement, Yom Kippur. Rosh Hashanah is also known as the Day of Shofar Blowing, the Day of Remembrance, and the Day of Judgment. Rosh Hashanah is a two-day celebration. Rosh Hashanah is the first of the Jewish High Holy Days, and the anniversary of the creation of Adam and Eve. Rosh Hashanah is a two-day new year celebration beginning on the first day of Tishrei - the first month of the Jewish lunar year. According to the Hebrew calendar, days begin at sundown. Hence, Rosh Hashanah begins the evening before Rosh Hashanah day.
