
Mazo Matters: Monday, November 6-10, 2023

Safety at Entry and Dismissal in the Bus Loop:

Morning entry and afternoon dismissal are two very busy times of day. We have 18 school buses that enter our bus loop between 7:45 am and 8:00 am and again between 2:20 pm and 2:50 pm. During those times, it is important that cars do not enter the bus loop to compete for space in order to ensure student and staff safety. If you drive your child to and from school, please use the Kiss 'N Ride loop at the south end of our parking lot. Please make the drop off quick and safe to maintain the flow of traffic. Alternatively, please use side streets to park your car and determine a meeting spot where you may walk to pick up your child. We appreciate your understanding and cooperation.

Remembrance Day

Each year as we commemorate Remembrance Day at Mazo, we try to include as many family and community connections as possible in our ceremony. In the past several years we have incorporated pictures of Canadian and allied veterans in a slideshow that is presented to the school. This year we would like to refresh our school slideshow, to reflect the new additions to our Mazo community. If you have contributed last year - thank you, there is no need to create a new slide.

You can create a slide contribution by having your child join our Remembrance Day Google Classroom and access the slide deck assignment. There are examples posted as well as instructions in the virtual classroom. Please insert a photo(s) along with the details of the picture (name, time and location of service, etc.). It is important to understand these images will be shown to the school and surrounding community. All slide decks are due by Monday, November 6, 2023. The classroom code is p3nymo5.

If you have veteran family members or friends from our community service groups (police/fire/emergency) that would like to participate in our honour guard on Friday, November 10, 2023, during our school ceremony please contact the office for further details.

Students who participate in Cadet programs, Guides, Scouts, etc. are encouraged to wear their uniforms on Remembrance Day and join the honour guard for the day's ceremony. Mazo community members are invited to join us for the ceremony as well.

Our Grade 2 and 3 students will have a shorter ceremony at 9:30 am. Grade 4-8 students will have their ceremony at 10:30a m. Parent(s)/guardians are welcome to come for our 10:30 am assembly. Seating is limited and is first come, first serve. Please ensure that you get a visitor's badge from the table in front of the office before entering the gym.

Poppies:

The Legion will be providing our school with poppies for our students to wear on November 10 during our Remembrance Day assembly. There is no charge for these poppies, but donations to the Legion Poppy Campaign are very welcome. Any donations can be sent to school with your child and left with the teacher. The money collected will go towards supporting our veterans and their families. We appreciate your support.
