Schools Closed to Students beginning Monday, October 7, 2019 due to CUPE School Support Staff Members Strike

Notice has been provided by CUPE, the provincial school support staff members' union that all YRDSB school support staff will be on strike beginning Monday, October 7, 2019.

If the strike proceeds, on Monday, October 7, 2019, all schools will be closed to students for the duration of the strike. All transportation services (including buses, taxis, etc.) and before and after care programs are cancelled. Independent child-care programs in schools may continue - please contact your childcare provider.

You must make alternate arrangements for your children beginning Monday, October 7, 2019.
