

Important School Information

Kiss and Ride – Parking Lot information

Each day at Meadowbrook PS, students are bussed, walk, ride bikes, and are dropped-off and picked-up in cars by caring adults. Transitional times during morning arrival and afternoon dismissal coincide with the busiest times in our parking when traffic is at its highest volume. For those who live within walking distance, we encourage walking students to school or parking a short distance away and walking in to avoid unsafe congestion.

Morning Procedure:

To ensure the safety of all students and to improve the flow of traffic in the morning, families are invited to drop children off at our kiss and ride where they will be met by a Meadowbrook PS staff member who will supervise their transition to school. Parents and caregivers who wish to enter the school with a child must park their car in the parking lot or safely on a side street to avoid impeding fire and bus routes. No vehicles should be parked along the curb of the bus loop.

Afternoon Procedure:

In the afternoon, our bus loop will be closed at 2:30 and blocked with pylons to ensure student safety at dismissal. Please do not enter the bus loop until after the busses leave. We ask that no cars park along the bus route. Our parking lot has limited capacity and becomes very busy at pick up. We highly recommend walking to meet students rather than driving.

Kg Dismissal:

Please note that Mrs. Umansky and Ms. Cox will be dismissing students from the north door to help reduce congestion out front. Please meet your Kg child at the north door.

At Meadowbrook PS we are committed to the safety and well-being of each child. We thank each of you in advance for adhering to our Kiss and Ride procedure and invite you to contact Mrs. Doran or Mr. Johnstone in the main office if you need any additional information or clarification about our renewed Kiss and Ride procedure.

Cell Phones:

Students are not permitted to use cell phones at recess, in hallways, washrooms, changerooms or in class (unless specifically requested by the teacher). As a result, students should not be expected to respond to texts or messages during the school day. If you need an important message to reach your child during the day, please call the office and we will be happy to assist. If students have important information to share with parents during the day, they may come to the office to use the phone.
