Each year, millions of Canadians and people throughout the world have participated in the Terry Fox Run. This annual event is held as a fundraiser for cancer research in honour of the great Canadian, Terry Fox, who courageously battled cancer and spearheaded the Marathon of Hope in 1980.

Now that September is here we are preparing for our annual Terry Fox Run/Walk on Friday, September 28th, raindate Tuesday, October 2nd. The students will be running/walking as many kilometers around a marked route at George Richardson Park. Please ensure your child has a labelled reuseable water bottle and an extra pair of socks on that day. You have already given consent to take your child off of school property through the Community-Based Activity Permission Form.

Once again we are asking each student to contribute a **Toonie for Terry**. We encourage any and all students to surpass this amount by asking their friends and family for support in the form of a donation. Online donating is simple and you will receive your tax receipt immediately. For safety reasons, we request that students do not go door-to-door asking for donations. Tax receipts will be issued for donations of \$20.00 or more. All money raised will be forwarded to the Terry Fox Foundation. We are very proud of our involvement and contribution. Our school community has raised over \$9,500 in the past. We have been participating for 12 years now and our 10 year banner is posted in our gym with our other athletic banners.

If we raise \$1,000.00 as a school, Mrs. Doran and Mr. Johnstone have agreed to dress as each other for one day.

Let's keep Terry's dream alive and help find a cure for cancer. We thank you in advance for your support of this important Canadian event.
