Attendance and Safe Arrival

Reporting your child's absence:

- 1) Parents/guardians must telephone the school at 905-832-4922 before 8:00 a.m. to leave a message with your child's name, teacher, and the reason for the absence. This is part of our new INFORM process. Please speak clearly and spell your child's name when leaving a message. Families may also login and use EDSBY.
- 2) Contact the school if your child will be arriving late, or if not returning after lunch.
- 3) Put a note in your child's agenda indicating an appointment that requires that he/she will arrive late or must leave the school during the day.

Students must sign in and out of the school using the binder in the school office.

IF YOUR CHILD IS NOT AT SCHOOL AND IS NOT ACCOUNTED FOR BY A NOTE OR TELEPHONE CALL, THE SCHOOL WILL:

- 1) Call home to check (and if not accounted for)
- 2) Call the parents at work (and if the child is still not accounted for)
- 3) Call the emergency numbers (and if the child is still not accounted for)



4) We will then telephone the York Regional Police, as per our safe arrival policy.

Please note that our school voicemail service is available outside of our regular office hours of 8:00 a.m. to 2:35 p.m. You may leave a message at any time.

Bussing Information

York Region District School Board Policy states that the walking distance for students from Kindergarten to grade 3 is 1.2 km and for students from grades 4 - 8 is 1.6 km. Students who live within our boundaries but beyond the distances stated above, are eligible for bus transportation as long as they adhere to safety and behaviour rules.

As well, students MUST ride the bus to which they have been assigned. They must also get on and off the bus at their assigned stop. Students will not be allowed to switch buses or to take friends home on the bus unless their parent/guardian sends a written request to the school for that particular day. If there is room on the bus, the office will sign the note and the driver may allow the student on their bus.

Please keep the school bus website <u>www.schoolbuscity.com</u> and telephone hotline 1-866-287-7837 handy to check route updates for your child. Each year, your child's bus number and route may change as students move in and out of the area. Once set for the year (usually by mid-September), the school will advise you of any changes to your child's route.

Bring Your Own Device: What Parents Need to Know

The possession of and use of a variety of electronic devices is definitely part of today's fast paced society. Students must sign a waiver with their homeroom teacher if they would like to use a device to help them with their school assignments. The responsibility for this device lies solely with the student and the school cannot be responsible for theft or damage.

However, at Michael Cranny the use of cell phones during the school day to make phone calls, text or use social media for personal purposes is **not allowed**. If your child needs to contact you during the day, s/he may come to the school office and request the use of the landline. Should your child bring a cell phone to school, it needs to be turned off or silenced upon entering the building and may only be used for online access under the direct supervision of the teacher for educational purposes.

Lunch Assistants Needed

At this time we are looking for Lunch Assistants for the 2021-2022 school year and to be on our back-up list.

Lunch Assistants will be required to help in our school during the full lunch hour each day (11:55pm – 12:55pm).

The duties include:

- Supervise classroom(s) during lunch hour
- Supervise outdoor or indoor (depending on weather) recess.

Being Prepared - Helpful Tips for Parents

Here are some additional items that are very helpful for parents to consider:

- Send an inexpensive pair of indoor shoes to be kept at school and to ensure your child's feet are dry and clean. This will also assist in maintaining cleanliness of the school.
- For Kindergarten and Primary Students, send an extra set of clothing (i.e., undergarments, pants and tops), masks, etc. in a labelled, clear bag. This goes a long way in the event of accidents or wet weather.
- A bag or backpack and reusable lunch bag will allow your child to bring important school notices and homework back and forth to school in good condition.
- Labelling your child's clothing would be helpful. Our lost and found is often full with unclaimed items. Lost items are kept in our Lost and Found box in the front hall.

Creating Safe and Healthy Schools for Children with Allergies

School staff and parents are responsible for creating safe and healthy environments for students. Our school has a number of students and staff with food allergies, some of which can be life-threatening. While we take every step to create a risk-free environment, school staff and parents can take important steps to minimize potentially fatal allergic reactions. It is especially important that parents communicate a life-threatening allergy to the school as soon as they are aware of it. Please notify the principal and your child's teacher so that we take the steps to create accurate records and inform staff of the established protocol. Parents will also be required to fill in a medical form.

Parents, **do not send any food items** to celebrate a birthday, as they will not be distributed, both in support of our anaphylaxis policy and healthy schools policy. Please refer to the Healthy Schools insert in the School Start-Up Package for more details.

If your child requires any other type of medication, please see the school office where you will be required to fill in a medical form. Students may not keep medication with them in their desks, lockers or schoolbags, with the exception of puffers and epi-pens.

First Day Procedures for September 9, 2021

To ensure that the first day of school on September 9th goes smoothly, we are seeking your cooperation in following the instructions outlined below:

1. START THE YEAR ON THE RIGHT FOOT!

Have your child(ren) <u>walk</u> to and from school if possible. This will go a long way to alleviating the inevitable traffic congestion on Melville Avenue. Please remember with the large amount of busses at our school each year, we kindly ask parents not to come into the parking lot at the beginning or end of each school day..

2. BE ON TIME!

- Yard/Staggered supervision begins at 8:00 a.m. Our school bell rings at 8:15 a.m. for classes to begin.
- Kindergarten students will meet their teachers in the fenced play yard. Please note that the school will be emailing families in the coming days about the specific routines for first day of school and staggered entry for our first year Kindergarten students in JK.
- Grades 1-8 will meet at the back of the tarmac and line up by your class sign taped on the walls of the school. At 8:15 a.m., staff will make their way out to the tarmac area at the back of the school and have students line up based on their class assignment. Please note an email will be sent out shortly with more information.
- Once all the students have lined up with their appropriate classes, students will be brought in grade by grade.
- Please ensure students and parents/guardians are wearing a mask and maintain a two metres distance.
- If your child is new or not on a staff list, please make your way to the front doors of the school to access the office for assistance. If there is a large line, families may also go home and call the school at 905-832-4922 for office staff to assist with registration.
- At 2:35 p.m., students will be brought back to the same location they met in the morning for dismissal.
- An email will be sent closer to September 9th outlining first day procedures with more detailed information.

3. COME PREPARED TO LEARN AND WORK HARD!

Ensure your child(ren) get at least 8 hours sleep, eat a good breakfast and bring a nutritious snack for the morning recess and lunch along with a water bottle each and every day! Reminder due to Covid-19, no lunches/snacks, etc. will be accepted at the school once the bell has gone.

4. DRESS APPROPRIATELY

Summertime temperatures often extend well into September. A T-shirt and shorts are always in

fashion and will help keep your child cool. Please check the weather daily as we do go outside everyday in all types of weather! Pack extra clothes labelled in a ziplock.

Our school will communicate more information as features become available.


For Edsby to be effective, it contains personal information about you and your family that is collected by the Board at registration. This information is used to provide services and support to you and your family. Edsby has been designed as a secure system that protects the privacy of this information for our families.

Setting up your Edsby Account for the first time

Should you require assistance setting up Edsby or accessing your current account please connect with the office who can share instructions on how to create an Edsby account. Make sure the school office has your current email address on file.

If you do not see the email, please check your junk mail folder to ensure you do not miss this opportunity.

- Click the link in the email. The browser will send you to a screen like the one on the right.
- Click the "I don't have an Edsby parent account" button. Your username will be your email address. You will choose your password. Similar to a banking password, it is important to choose a strong password. Please do not share your password.



 Click "Create Edsby Account." A "Welcome to Edsby" message will be sent to your email address.

Frequently Asked Questions



What can I do if I do not see the invitation in my email inbox?

Check your junk mail and/or mail settings for an email issued from YRDSB. Your email address on file at your child's school must match the email address for Edsby. If they do not match, contact your child's school to update your email address and reissue an invitation. Updates to email addresses for using Edsby take 24 hours.

What if I accidentally decline the invitation from my child's school?

You will need to contact your child's school so they may issue a new invitation to your email address.

What do I do if I forgot my password?

Go to the Edsby login page (http://yrdsb.edsby.com), then click "Can't log in" at the bottom of the page. You will be prompted to enter your username (full email address on file). A temporary password will be sent to your email address and you will be asked to create a new password.

What do I do if I forget my login information?

Your Edsby username is your full email address that you provided to your child's school. If you forgot your username or changed your username, you will need to contact your child's school to verify the email address on file. Updates to email addresses for Edsby logins will take at least 24 hours.

Why does my Edsby account not show correctly on my screen?

Make sure to enable cookies and JavaScript on your browser (consult the help section of your browser). Edsby supports Google Chrome, Apple Safari, Mozilla Firefox, and Internet Explorer (IE 10 or higher).

How do I sign in using the Edsby App?

Download the Edsby app for your mobile device. Open the app. Enter "**yrdsb**" for your server address when asked. Then enter your Edsby username (full email address) and password.

Why can I not see my other child(ren) or messages from their school(s)?

If you have children at other schools, you will receive a separate invitation for those students. When you select the link in the email, you will select "I have an Edsby account" and enter your login and password. Your children will be added to your account. As long as you are using the same email address, your children should all



appear. If you do not see a child in your Edsby account, please contact the school of that child.
