

French Immersion Information Sessions and Registrations

Information sessions for the French Immersion (FI) program will take place at French Immersion schools on January 18, 2018 at 7 p.m. Please visit YRDSB's website in January 2018 (http://www.yrdsb.ca/Programs/fi/Pages/Program-Locations.aspx) to find the FI program location for your elementary school location. FI registration will begin January 19, 2018. Parents or guardians of Senior Kindergarten students entering Grade 1 in 2018, and wishing to enrol in the FI Program, can visit or call the school office and request an *Office Index Card - short version*. The Office Index Card must be signed by the principal of the home school. Parents or guardians then take this form, along with one piece of identification showing their address to the designated FI program location to register between January 19 and February 9, 2018. This eliminates the need to provide duplicate enrollment information or to pre-register.

YRDSB's FI Accommodation Plan provides long-term consistency and equity of access to all students in York Region and will enable YRDSB to continue to offer the FI program to all who wish to enrol. The FI program will be offered in Dual Track or Single Track settings, in a variety of configurations. In order to meet community needs and optimize available space in our schools, a community's Grade 1-8 FI program may be provided over more than one school during the course of a student's FI education. Space requirements at some schools may mean that siblings are in different schools for primary dual track French Immersion programs due to differing grade structures. Like any of our schools across the Board, changes to school boundaries, and/or the accommodation model for the French Immersion program may need to be considered when new schools open, a school experiences enrolment growth, and program changes occur. This will allow flexibility in addressing community needs and the opportunity to use existing space in schools.

Please note: Some of the FI accommodation plans will require facility modifications or the development of new schools and will require short-term transition plans that might include overflow while we work toward the long-term vision. Overflow refers to situations in which the Board directs students to attend a school other than their community school or optional program for a specific period of time, as defined in Policy #108.



Kindergarten Registration Commences on January 19, 2018

Kindergarten registration will commence on January 19, 2018 for the 2018-19 school year. Registration forms are available on YRDSB's website: <u>www.yrdsb.ca</u>. Children who turn four or five years old during 2018, live within the school boundary and whose parents are public school tax supporters will be eligible to register for kindergarten. A kindergarten information session for parents is being planned for this spring. For more information, please visit the YRDSB website or contact your local school.

BUS CANCELLATIONS DUE TO INCLEMENT WEATHER

SCHOOLS REMAIN OPEN

During an Inclement Weather Day, the school is open and alternate programming may be provided depending on the number of students in attendance on this day.

PIZZA/PITA LUNCH & KIDS' KITCHEN

If Pizza or Pita Lunches are scheduled on an Inclement Weather Day they will be *cancelled and rescheduled*.

All Kids' Kitchen orders will be delivered, unless cancelled by phone **before 8:00AM** on the day of delivery.

DROP OFF/PICK UP

Students who come to school on a Snow Day may be dropped off and picked up through the parking lot loop. Pick up will begin at 2:00 pm. Please pick up your child by 2:20 pm.

School Bus Cancellation Notice

To ensure the safety of students, school bus service may be cancelled due to inclement weather, extreme temperatures and/or poor road conditions. In these cases, parents and students should develop alternate care/transportation arrangements.

Cancellation decisions will only be made after thorough consultation with the Safety Officers of school bus companies servicing York Region and are based on several factors including precipitation, air temperature, road conditions and weather forecast.

Please note the following;

- A decision to cancel school bus service will be **region-wide** meaning all school buses, vans and taxis will not operate.
- School bus routes may be cancelled when severe weather may not be affecting all municipalities in York Region. Both the YRDSB and YCDSB operate many regional educational programs. Students attending these programs are transported over large attendance areas encompassing several municipal boundaries. This limits the ability to cancel bus service using a municipality or zone methodology.
- When bus service is cancelled all school tests and/or examinations will be cancelled and rescheduled.
- Student trips involving the use of school buses will also be cancelled.
- Unless otherwise stated, schools will remain open and parents can make arrangements to transport their children to and from school even if school bus service is cancelled. If buses are cancelled in the morning, they will not operate in the afternoon. Therefore, students transported to school by parents will require the same transportation home.

Dear Parents,

As you know Parent Teacher Interviews were held at the end of November and we used a new tool to schedule meetings with teachers. With any new tool, there is new learning for both parents and school staff. Thank you for your patience and willingness to try something new and learn alongside us.

We have received feedback from parents and we have provided this feedback to the project team and our Information Technology Services Department who will continue to improve the Parent Teacher Interview online process.

We have also received some questions about Edsby and wanted to share some additional information with you.

Edsby is a cloud-based platform that will let families see what's happening with your child at school, and helps you play a more active part in your child's education.

York Region District School Board, in partnership with Edsby, has created a secure platform that protects the privacy of information for YRDSB families. Edsby will never ask you for personal information by email.

Edsby uses the email address you provided to the school to send you an invitation to create an account using this same email as your login. Two people will not be able to use the same email address to create an account. Using the link in the invitation, you will be asked to create a password and upon logging in to verify the information you have already provided to the school for the purpose of communication. If you do not wish to activate your account or receive further invitations, you may decline the invitation - although we do hope you join us in Edsby.

Once you have activated an account you can access Edsby at <u>https://yrdsb.edsby.com</u> or download the app from your app store to access it on your tablet or cell phone. If you use the app, we recommend having a password on your phone.

If you did not activate your Edsby account for (Parent Teacher Interview/Student-Led Conference) scheduling, you will have another opportunity to join Edsby in the near future.

Edsby offers many different features that YRDSB will be rolling out in the coming years, including:

- Reporting planned absences
- School Communications
- Program Registration (International Baccalaureate Program, Summer Institute)
- Accessing your child's schedule (including scheduled classes, assignments and group/school/class/personal events)
