ONTARIO SECONDARY SCHOOL LITERACY TEST (OSSLT)

- Administered in Grade 10 (SPRING)
- The Ontario Secondary School Literacy Test (OSSLT) measures whether students are meeting the minimum standard for literacy across all subjects up to the end of Grade 9



Community Involvement

- A graduation diploma requirement
- Complete 40 hours of volunteering before graduation
- Student may begin to document hours after they graduate from Grade 8
- Hours are submitted and approved by a Guidance Counsellor.
