We hope you have had a fun summer and look forward to seeing you in the fall. Registration for the 2017-2018 school year will open online on Monday, August 14<sup>th</sup> through School Cash Online.

School Cash Online allows parents/guardians to pay electronically for a variety of school-related programs, items and events and can be accessed at [www.schoolcashonline.com](http://www.schoolcashonline.com) or on the school's main home page at [www.mmhs.ca](http://www.mmhs.ca) (scroll down to the right hand side of the main page). **Please note, all future field trips and other school related fees will be accessed through this platform.**

**If you register and pay for your items on School Cash Online**, you will be receiving your timetables electronically the following week. In addition, you will no longer have to wait in line to complete your registration and can proceed directly to take your photo for your school id card in the cafeteria on Registration Day. As a reminder, Registration Day will be held in the school on Tuesday, August 29<sup>th</sup> and Wednesday, August 30<sup>th</sup> from 9-11:30am and 1-3pm. All students will receive important school information in hard copy form on Wednesday, September 6<sup>th</sup> in homerooms.

**Prior to registering for School Cash Online**, you will need to set up an account. Please follow the steps on the website and/or directions provided at: <http://www.yrdsb.ca/boarddocs/Pages/SchoolCash-Online-Parents.aspx>. You will need parent or guardian assistance as a credit card or banking information is required for online payment, as well as their student number.

1:00 p.m. – 3:00 p.m.

Once you have registered for School Cash Online, you may proceed to the cafeteria to take your school photo for your student id card. All students will receive important school information in hard copy form on Wednesday, September 6<sup>th</sup> in homerooms.
