What is the OSSLT?

The Ontario Secondary School Literacy Test (OSSLT) measures whether students are meeting the standard for literacy across all subjects up to the end of Grade 9.

All students who want to graduate with an OSSD must complete a literacy requirement.

This can be done in <u>TWO</u> ways:

- By being successful on the OSSLT
- Completing the Ontario Literacy Course (OLC); you can take the OLC without attempting the test

What if I am "unsuccessful"?

- 1. Rewrite in the spring
 - a. Consider taking the After School Literacy course in the spring to help prepare for the OSSLT again
- 2. For students who need a lot more support, OLC may be offered

How do I know if I'm writing?

You will receive one of the following letters:

- DEFERRAL Will write in the Spring
- OSSLT Participation Letter Writing in November
 - Includes dates, time and location
- OSSLT Participation/Accommodation Letter Writing in November
 - Includes dates, time, location and accommodations

The OSSLT - BIG IDEAS

- OSSLT is a computer-based assessment
- 2 sessions:
 - Session A approximately 65 minutes
 - Session B approximately 75 minutes
- All students are entitled to use extra time as needed
- There are many built-in accommodations on the online platform



In the meantime, check out the resources to help you get ready to do your best!




On desktops, students access the secure browser by clicking on "YR-OSSLT" - if you are prompted for a code, enter 6768


PLAN B: Login to the OSSLT through EQAO!

- Choose the "STUDENTS" login and enter using the Access Code provided and your OEN









Test Day Procedures

- 1. Find a seat at a computer/ chromebook and turn it on:
 - Desktops: Turn on and click on the YR-OSSLT icon and password is 6768.
 - o Chromebooks: Click on K (Kiosk).
- 2. Login using your OEN Number (on the label provided) and the access code on the board once test kiosk loads.
- 3. Teacher will read the script.
- 4. Begin Session A after the script is read to you.
- 5. Read instructions and follow the session instructions very carefully.
- 6. Do not press "submit" until you've completed all the sections/questions do not rush.




Types of OSSLT Multiple-Choice Questions











OSSLT Support & Tips

BEFORE the OSSLT, please DISABLE all online writing assistance applications on your profile.

1. GO TO THE SETTING - TOP RIGHT (3 DOTS)






3. TOGGLE OFF any Online Writing Assistance extensions.

DISABLE "spell check" in your chromebook settings.





- Click on the Time/Battery and select the Settings gear
- 2. In Settings, search "SPELL CHECK"



3. Turn off SPELL CHECK in chromebook settings

If you expect to use extra time, please bring a snack with you.





General Tips


- Manage your time
