

You must cite sources that you have paraphrased, quoted, summarized or otherwise used to write your research paper. Citations appear in two places. They can appear at the end of your paper on the References page. They can also appear in the body of your paper. These are called in-text citations.

### Here is an example of a **References** page:

## **Rules for Formatting a References Page**

- Start the References list on a separate page at the end of your paper.
- Put the title of your paper on the top left hand corner and the page number on the top right hand corner.
- Use the title References beneath. Centre the title.
- Start the first line of each citation at the left hand margin. Indent each subsequent line for the citation.
- Put the sources in alphabetical order, using the first letter beginning each entry.
   Usually the author's last name is the first piece of info. Use initials for the author's first/middle names.

Most in-text citations include the author's name and year of publication in parentheses at the end of the sentence. Here is an example of an **in-text citation**:

The father's role in parenting is crucial but often overlooked (West, 1998).

#### There are some exceptions:

Put the year of the publication after the name if you mention the author in the sentence.

Eagan (2005) describes factors that contribute to behaviour changes exhibited by children of divorce.



When you are paraphrasing, you do not need to add the page number; however, your teacher may ask you to include it.


