Inclement Weather Conditions and School Bus Cancellations: You can access local radio and television stations after 6:00 a.m. to receive bus cancellation information. A bus cancellation message will also be available at www.schoolbuscity.com and 1-877-330-3001 or by following the YRDSB on Twitter. Unless otherwise stated, schools will remain open and parents can make arrangements to transport their children to and from school. If buses are cancelled in the morning, they will not operate in the afternoon and there will be no after school events. Therefore students transported to school by parents, they must be picked up by 2:40 p.m. There is no supervision for students after our dismissal time. Teacher supervision is available in the morning from 8:05am—8:15am. Students should not be dropped off before 8:05am for their own safety.
