Treasurers Report

Balance Forward: \$8,762.79

 Revenue: \$20,305.44
 Floating Balance: \$9,659.96

- \$7,000 outstanding that has not been transferred
 - o \$1,500 Music
 - o \$5,000 Wish List
 - o \$500 Playgound
- Council has typically provided \$10 per child for graduation
- Hot lunch should cover the outstanding balance and there should not be a need for any additional fundraising
- Basket fundraiser raised \$1,731
- If we are looking for a new fundraiser for the spring, it was suggested that another Basket Fundraiser would be fairly easy to run and is popular with the children

Admin Report

- Received cards from partner school (Lakeside) and parents as thank you for 12 days of Christmas
- Both basketball teams won regionals and finished within one point of top 4 for the Province

 determined that they were no longer required due to changes in the handling of
 finances within the school. The only duty required to carry forward was the
 delivery of the financial report.
 - The duty of "Deliver Financial Report" will be transferred to the Secretary role.

New Business
