Are schools able to fundraise? What are the guidelines?

- At this time, school based fundraising may take place under the following conditions outlined below:
  - Schools cannot fundraise for COVID-19 health protection PPE as Boards are required to procure these through a centralized process as mandated by the Ministry of Education. This would include fundraising to purchase PPE for the school and the sale of PPE (e.g., masks) to students/community to raise funds.
    - Schools are not to collect cash/cheques from students and families
    - All financial transactions must occur on-line using School Cash Online
    - Schools should not be hosting any in-person assemblies to promote their fundraising initiative
    - Students must be directed not to go “door to door” to solicit sponsors/product sales
    - Schools should not be accepting products that must be sent to the school first and then distributed to families. Direct shipment from the company to the family is permitted
    - All school fundraising activities must be in alignment with [Board Policy #676.0 School Fundraising and Administration of School Generated Funds](#)
