#### Welcome to Kindergarten

There will be two separate sessions/dates for Welcome to Kindergarten this year.

On Tuesday May 15th at 6:30 pm, we will be hosting a parent information session where parents will have an opportunity to learn more about the Kindergarten progam at Mount Joy and to ask questions. This session is for parents only.

On Thursday May 24th at 6:30pm, you and your child(ren) who will be starting Kindergarten Year 1 at Mount Joy are invited to join us for some fun hands on activities. You will have an opportunity to meet some of our Kindergarten staff on this evening.

#### What is the EQAO and why are students tested?

The EQAO is the provincial <u>Education Equality and Accountability Office</u>. It is an independent government body that develops and oversees reading, writing and mathematics tests that Ontario students must take in Grades 3, 6, 9, and 10.



The tests give parents, teachers, principals and school boards information about how well students have learned what the province expects them to learn in reading, writing and mathematics.

This year, our **grade 6s** will be completing the test from **May 23—May 25th**, and our **grade 3s** will be completing the test from **May 28th—May 30th**.

#### How can I help my child prepare?

There is no special preparation for the tests. Some teachers provide sample questions to help students understand what the tests will be like. The best way to help your child is to make sure he or she is rested and at school on time.

#### Walking School Bus/Bike Train Day

Mount Joy will be working in partnership with the City of Markham for our Walking School Bus/ Bike Train Day on May 31 to encourage our students and families to leave their cars at home!



If you are moving or changing schools, kindly notify the office at your earliest convenience so we can support you in the transfer process to provide a seamless transfer of schools for your children.

K-Cup pods and other single-use coffee pods are recyclable and can be recycled with your containers in your blue box or container recycling bin, once the top and coffee grounds have been removed. **Used coffee grounds** are neutral so you can use them in your garden or potted plants at home.

# **How to Recycle Your Single-use Coffee Pods**

- 1. Before throwing in the recycling, remove the plastic foil or top
- 2. Remove any coffee grounds that are still in the pod with a rinse
- 3. Place the empty coffee **pod container into your recycling bin**
