	The Chippewas of Georgina Island are our closest First Nation community and our partners in education.	
	Treaties teach us that all who live here should be respectful of one another. They also teach us that the land is our responsibility. All of nature, the earth, the waters, the plants, the animals are important to Indigenous people. Treaties remind us that we must care for mother earth to keep her healthy for those who will live here in the future.
