#### **Summer School Information**

Some updates regarding summer school information:

- Several courses that were offered face to face have been switched to remote (synchronous) learning due to low enrollment. Students affected have received an email to their GAPPS accounts
- All 2 week credit reinforcement (credit recovery) and credit upgrading courses will now be remote (synchronous) as opposed to face to face
- All online (asynchronous) courses are waitlisted

Summer school registration is now closed, with the exception of credit reinforcement (credit recovery) and credit upgrading. These programs are all offered virtually.
