### From the Grade 9 French Class



The Gr.9 French classes explored the cultural aspects of the French curriculum by going to watch *le Voyage de Fanny*, a Belgian movie that was acquired for them by special request at Cineplex Odeon Newmarket. Via this film, released in 2016, the students deepened their understanding of the plight of Jewish people during World War II. The story is based on the autobiography of Fanny Ben Ami, a young girl who, at age 13, fled through occupied France to the Swiss border with eight children in tow. Everyone appreciated the cultural-linguistic-historical learning as well as the inspiring story! Afterwards, we enjoyed a lighter atmosphere at Crêpe Star Newmarket where we feasted on French-style crêpes. Bravo, les 9èmes!
