



Community Involvement

- 40 hours needed to graduate
changes for this year only
 - Up to **10 hours** for **paid employment**
 - hours for “duties normally performed in the home”
- Try to get it done by the end of grade 11
- Ask your guidance counsellor to make sure your activity is eligible & get it pre-approved
- Opportunities available on Guidance Google Classroom and the Community Involvement Board next to the Guidance office





Summer School Reminders

- runs in July
- **Reinforcement** – 2 weeks - for students who were unsuccessful, and are approved by the credit recovery team
- **Acceleration** – 4 weeks - for students who have never taken the course before, or who were unsuccessful but did not meet the criteria for credit recovery (**no grade 9 acceleration courses offered**)
- Sign up starting in **April**


