

Applying Online to Ontario's Universities

101 Online Application for Ontario High School Students



Two Step Process

Step 1:

Apply to university through the Ontario University Application Centre (OUAC)

Step 2:

Stay connected to with chosen universities through their online/portal site.

- * be sure to check each site regularly
- * universities will post messages to their sites – they will not always email your personal account.

Step 1:

Get Your OUAC Access Codes

Your guidance counsellor will give you a confidential letter containing your access codes:

- **Temporary PIN**
- **School Number (942340)**
- **Student Number (000+9 digit student number)**

These numbers allow you to access your 101 Online Application.

Your PIN is confidential!
Don't share it with anyone else.

Research Your University Options

- Visit **eINFO** (www.electronicinfo.ca) to see what each university has to offer. Review the eINFO Postcard.
- Check out university publications, websites and tours.
- Talk to counsellors, family, teachers and friends.
- Write down your program choices and codes, and keep them handy.

Mark Your Calendar

- **January 17, 2018:** Deadline to submit your completed application to the OUAC.
- **May 29, 2018:** Latest date you can expect a response to your application for admission.
- **June 1, 2018:** The earliest date you may be required to respond to an Ontario university offer of admission and give a financial commitment (e.g., registration deposit, residence deposit, etc.).

Answer a [few short questions](#) to make sure you're applying with the right application.

You should complete the 101 online application if you meet **all** of the following:

- You are taking courses during the day at an Ontario high school during the current semester and graduated students returning to upgrade one or more courses.
- You have not, at some point, been out of high school for more than 12 months.
- You will have received or expect to receive your Ontario Secondary School Diploma or Ontario Secondary School Certificate by the end of the current year.
- You have not attended a postsecondary institution (college/university/career college).
- You are applying to the first year of an undergraduate degree program or diploma program at an Ontario university.
- You are under 21 years of age.



- The OUAC accepts MasterCard, VISA or American Express. **Note:** A CVD is required ([What is a CVD?](#))
- The OUAC cannot process credit card payments over the telephone. Prepaid credit cards and VISA debit cards are not accepted.
- If your credit card is declined or invalid, the application will not be processed.
- When you click "Continue", you will be directed to a secure third party website for processing. When your credit card transaction is complete, you will be directed back to your application. You will then be emailed copy of your credit card transaction.

The OUAC cannot process your application without the application fee.

Step 2: Institution Portal / Intranet Site

- You should receive two emails from each university you apply to.
 - 1st email: generic welcome email
(usually within 24 hours)
 - 2nd email: site specific log in information
(usually within 7 days)
- Get into the habit of regularly checking each university specific site for program specific messages/updates/requirements.

- scholarship and bursary applications
- tuition deposit and tuition payment information
- residence requirements and links
- course selection/timetable creation (*late spring/early summer*)
