Preliminary Matters

- Approval of Minutes November 5th Minutes
 - o Motion by Roman Kanter, second by John Kennedy, all in favour

Principal's & Vice Principal's Report

- Front Door Security
 - Beginning February 3rd
 - Door to be locked 15 minutes post-commencement of classes
 - The policy is new to the school board, so there may be some issues to iron out
 - Wendy Thompson is encouraging council members to inform others about the new policy and to show patience as issues are being worked out
- Registration Starting January 17
 - There is space for everyone, so Wendy is asking that only those registering for kindergarten come on January 17
 - Registration will also begin for grade 1 French Immersion any NMPS senior kindergarten registered, is to register at NMPS – there are no limits as to how many children will be let into French Immersion
 - Any others go to Ventura to register, even Forest Run overflow
 - Grade 7 students at NMPS have the choice of staying at NMPS for 2014 or going to Anne Frank PS – decision needs to be made before March break – a note will be sent to parents instructing by when and how they are to inform the school of the decision
