Opening

- Mark welcomed everyone
- Meeting commenced at 6:30

Preliminary Matters

- Approval of Minutes January 14th Minutes
 - Motion by Mike Kemper and seconded by Gayla Ber. Motion approved.

Principal's Report

- Funds request
 - document cameras, wants 6 for the portables, wants access to technology for portables, cost is \$381.15/per - \$2584.19 includes HST
 - need LCDs to view document cameras and we only have 1 for the portables
 - suggested to buy 2 more doc cameras and 2 LCD projectors
 - Math manipulatives junior team is requesting more manipulatives, cost \$1013.05
 - Books cost \$14,000 literacy and book resources across all 3 divisions. Top up level books for guided reading program. PM writing for Grades 1-4. Grades 3-5 National Geographic goes with science curriculum. Grade 7-8 series on social justice. Books are shared amongst the classrooms. 60 different 6 packs for K-3.
 - A motion was made by Marina to purchase 3 document cameras and 2 LCD projectors for \$2266.75. John seconded the motion. Motion Passed.
 - A motion was made by Marina to purchase Math Manipulatives totaling \$1013.05 and seconded by John. Motion Passed.
 - A motion was made Marina to purchase the books totaling \$14,000.00 and seconded by John. Motion passed.
- Bully survey was done anonymously just after winter break for Grades 4-8:
 - o tallied results and shared with the staff
 - Wendy and Candace have been sharing the results with the kids
 - most common verbal and social/emotional
 - happening at recess and lunch on the field and pavement
 - can't see verbal or social/emotional bullying
 - some students stood out in the bully survey
 - shared with a parent about one student
 - going to do it again and going to revise the survey
 - shared with staff that kids come to them and teacher is not listening
 - students need to know we care
 - 55 students identified as bullies Grade 5 or up
 - 40 students identified two or more Grade 5 or up
 - preamble explained to students about types and that it is happening currently
 - some students are being spoken to already
 - o quite even between males and females

- Actions to improve include: some kids are removed from the restorative circles, parents called or brought in, creating growth plans, offering social skills clubs, agencies outside of school, social worker intervention
- JFCS social worker comes and does sessions with students
- learns where to focus time and energy to social/emotional bullying
- need education piece to explain to parents not to misuse the word bullying
- thinking of programs to implement: tribes throughout the school, kilometer club - gives students something to do at recess, future aces, random acts of kindness, character trait, focus on line of touchstone, second steps, learning buddies, peer mentoring
- On PA Day did mandatory training on caring communities and workplace from Ministry of Education. There was a threat component to report through writing to administrators. Annual training as well through Board.
- o talked about active communication and supervision from the staff
- a lot of work needs to come from within needs to train students where to go and how the staff should listen and act
 - Bob setup training with Parent Volunteers and Paid Parents
- Two social skills group run 6-8 weeks long
 - second session is running now with a primary and junior/intermediate group
 - o board wide opportunities for students to participate
 - o peace tree conference teacher attended with 5 junior students
- Wendy responded to Board that front door is not locked and community wants it locked. The Board is moving in the direction of the Ministry and has surveyed all schools about whether doors are currently locked. Apparently, the Ministry is providing funding for the Fall..
 - Parent community needs to abide by the rules of the school.
 - Constant push back from Parents and taking time away from what school staff should be doing.
 - Students need to feel comfortable telling issues to the parents.
 - Did a tour of the school to look at the security features of the school.
- Requested \$9,422.53 in funds from previous meetings. Some has been spent.
- Fun Fair
 - o need volunteers
 - do we want to save a date
 - o interested in June 9th
 - Wendy to send out email to parents asking for volunteers and to attend a meeting in march
- Cold weather policy
 - o board has a policy and discretion is also made by administrators
 - Changes are made based on the condition
