Preliminary Matters

- Approval of Minutes October 2nd Minutes
 - Motion to approve by Darren Greenspoon, seconded by Zvi Vaxman, all in favour

Principal's & Vice Principal's Report

- Boundary Meeting November 12, 7pm
 - Meeting to be held at NMPS in the gym
- Cold Weather Policy
 - Wendy Thompson discussed the cold weather policy
 - Stated that if a child is too sick to go outside they are too sick for school
 - The school has established criteria it uses when considering whether to keep students in or not; it is up to the discretion of the Principal
 - The policy is on the website
- Philanthropic Proposals:
 - Kid Like Me
 - Avery Zeidman described the program
 - Program to help kids learn empathy for other kids who may not be as well off as they are
 - Kids are paid for chores or other things they do around the house; the proceeds are then used to buy gifts for less fortunate kids
 - Can revolve around the holiday season
 - Food Drive
 - Maria Shtemberg presented the food drive idea
 - Students bring an item for the drive, and are provided with a ballot
 - There would then be a chance to win a field trip to the food bank for a select number of students, where they would deliver the food
 - Students would then present on their experience at a later assembly
 - Local food bank is on board and would provide flyers, bins and provide time at the food bank for sorting; will provide a list of most needed items
 - Grade 6, 7, 8 students could be used to take in food donations and provide ballots
 - Motion by Darren Greenspoon to support payment for a school bus for the food drive, seconded by John Kennedy, all in favour
 - Motion by Darren Greenspoon to go forward with both proposals, seconded by Maria Shtemberg, all in favour
