What is SHSM?

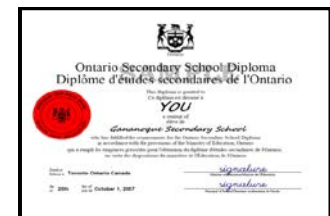
